

Day 1: Tuesday October 20, 2015 - Depart the USA: Depart LAX for Budapest, Hungary.

Day 2 Wednesday October 21, 2015: Arrive Budapest. On arrival at the airport, you'll be met by a friendly Jet Vacations representative and transferred to your deluxe Scenic cruise ship in Budapest. Here, you'll have the chance to unpack, relax in your room and explore all of the ship's fantastic facilities. This evening, you have an extra special invite to the Captain's Gala Dinner. Included excursions: a guided tour of Budapest. Included meals: Captain's Gala Dinner.

Day 4 Friday October 23, 2015: Bratislava. Today you'll experience the bustling pedestrian plazas and stylish street cafés of Bratislava. And for a more profound insight, you'll be taken on a sightseeing tour of the Old Town – home to a plethora of historical buildings. Must-see sights include the sobering Holocaust Memorial, the Museum of Jewish Culture and Slavin War Memorial, the magnificent Mirbach Palace and the Gothic cathedral of St Martin. Day 5 Saturday October 24, 2015: Vienna. Austria's vibrant city of Vienna is a fantastic fusion of old and new. As well as being known as 'The City of Music' because of its musical legacy, Vienna is also regarded as 'The City of Dreams' as it was home to Sigmund Freud – the world's first psychoanalyst. This afternoon you're free to explore the city, which is home to over 27 castles and a record-breaking 150 palaces. For a view of Vienna that simply can't be beaten, why not take a ride on the Riesenrad – the main square's giant Ferris Wheel? Visit St. Stephen's Cathedral with its 18 amazing authentic alters, the tomb of Emperor Frederick III, and the Maria Pötsch Icon – a Byzantine style icon of St. Mary with the child Jesus. From its dizzy heights, you'll be able to take in the city's fabulous sights from a truly unique vantage point. Alternatively, you can swap your free time this afternoon for an optional visit to Schönbrunn Palace – Empress Sisi's former summer residence, complete with an enchanting park, zoo and labyrinth. And in the evening, you can book an optional trip to watch a Viennese concert. Included excursions: a sightseeing drive along the Ringstrasse and a walking tour of Vienna. Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 6 Sunday October 25, 2015: Vienna – Dürnstien - Melk -. Sail from Vienna to Dürnstein where you'll enjoy a guided walking tour of the town and free time to explore its breath-taking scenery, rolling hillsides, and places of historic interest. Then sail through the great Wachau Valley – home to the 12th century castle where Richard the Lionheart was imprisoned after returning from the crusades Your tour of Austria's wine-growing region begins in Melk – a pretty town situated on the south bank of the Danube River. Here you'll explore a 900-year old Benedictine Abbey which is located above the town on a splendid rocky outcrop, overlooking where the Danube joins the Wachau Valley – an Austrian valley with a picturesque landscape. Boasting the finest Italian architecture, elaborate gold leaf walls, a 640ft Imperial Corridor and fabulous fresco ceilings, Melk Abbey is a beautiful sight to behold. SPECIAL FEATURE: a guided tour of Melk Abbey. Included excursions: a guided tour of Dürnstein. Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 7 Monday October 26, 2015: Linz - Passau. Situated at the confluence of the rivers Danube, Inn and IIz, today you're visiting Passau – the "Three Rivers City". On this morning, feel free to explore Linz's vibrant music and arts scene, museums, parks and many inner courtyards discretely hidden behind arched gates. See the Trinity Column or stop for an espresso and sample the famed Linzer Torte As an alternative you may book an optional full day tour (including lunch) to Salzburg in Austria – one of the best-preserved city centres north of the Alps and a UNESCO World Heritage Site, or you may prefer to visit Ceský Krumlov – a small city in the South Bohemian Region of the Czech Republic. After lunch onboard your ship, you'll set sail for the town of Passau, where you'll have an afternoon walking tour where you'll stroll through the cobblesone streets and narrow alleys before emerging to find the perfect view of the hilltop Oberhaus Fortress. Originally designed to serve the Bishop of Passau in 1219, it's today home to a fascinating museum, restaurant and open-air theatre. You'll then have the chance to appreciate the wonderfully ornate architecture of St. Stephen's Cathedral, which contains a wealth of treasures, including Europe's largest church organ, with over 17,000 pipes. SPECIAL FEATURE: evening entertainment with a traditional Bavarian Oompah Band. Included excursions: a walking tour of Passau. Included meals: breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Day 8 Tuesday October 27, 2015: Regensburg - Weltenburg On today's agenda is a relaxing sail along the delightful Danube Gorge which carves through magnificent 300ft cliffs before reaching Weltenburg Abbey. Founded by monks in 602 AD, Weltenburg Abbey is the oldest monastery in Bavaria and today boasts a courtyard surrounded by Baroque buildings. After exploring this ancient church and its grounds, you'll have the chance to sample Weltenburg's famous dark beer before returning to your ship in Regensburg. Here, you'll take a guided tour of Germany's best preserved medieval city, where architectural highlights include the Old Town Hall and one of the oldest bridges crossing the Danube. This evening's onboard entertainment is a traditional Bavarian Oompah Band, playing a selection of fantastic folk music into the night while you relax with a drink. This evening, you have an extra special invite to the Captain's Gala Dinner, where you'll have the chance to join your fellow guests. Included excursions: a guided tour of Weltenburg Abbey and Regensburg. Included meals: breakfast, lunch and Farewell Dinner.

Day 9: Wednesday October 28, 2015 - Nuremberg (FB): This Morning you will be transferred* by your Jet Vacations Representative to Nuremberg or Munich Airport for your onward or homebound flight or to your post extension to Prague. Cancelation Policies: No charges other than the nonrefundable initial deposit are levied for individual passengers canceling up to 120 days prior to the commencement of Jet Vacations LLC services. Full cancellation: Failing to pay the contractual deposits (other than the initial deposit) constitutes a cancellation. In the event of non-compliance with the payment due dates, Jet Vacations LLC shall have the right to demand the Customer to

be received by Jet Vacations LLC within eight days as of the date of Jet Vacations LLC's written request. Should payment not be received within this time limit, the group stay shall be deemed to be canceled by the Customer. In the event of full cancellation of the agreement by the Customer, which is not justified by Jet Vacations LLC's failure to meet its obligations. cancellation penalties shall be invoiced and calculated as follows:

Initial deposit**: 50% of initial deposit is non-refundable. Remaining 50% is non-refundable after 120 days.

At 120 days prior departure: 12% penalty of the total cost per person (or minimum of \$125 per person).

From 119 to 91 days prior to departure: 30% penalty of the total cost per person.

From 90 to 61 days prior to departure: 50% penalty of the total cost per person.

From 60 to 31 days prior to departure: 75% penalty of the total cost per person.

From 30 to day of departure & no show: 100% penalty of the

total cost per person. 50% of the first deposit to hold the space is non refundable. Remaining 50% and first deposit are non-refundable after 120
