I am very excited that the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce is partnering with the College and Career Pathways office at Pasadena Unified School District to help three career academies connect with relevant businesses.

The Chamber is working with the Health Careers and Culinary Arts and Hospitality Academies at Blair High School and the Law and Public Service Academy at Pasadena High School. We meet weekly with teachers to better understand their curriculum and how we can best support the students in the classroom and beyond.

This semester, we are actively seeking those in health professions, including alternative medicine, chiropractors, MDs and veterinarians to host students for career exploration/ job shadowing. If you are a hotel or motel manager, chef, restaurant manager, kitchen worker or server, the Culinary Arts and Hospitality Academy would appreciate an hour of your time to talk about your career with their students. Do you work in law or support the legal profession? Can you take time to talk with students about your business, career and opportunities in your profession? We can connect you with opportunities to enrich local students' career interests.

We are actively seeking internship opportunities for this summer in restaurants, hotels, health care providers, veterinarians, lawyers and more.

The Chamber is partnering with Ideal Youth to provide training and oversight for interns. Our staff, along with Ideal Youth, will screen, interview and select participants. Those selected be requiired to complete a training program that includes dress and behavior, ethics, taxes, money management and more. Before we send an intern to a host company, we will be confident that student will be an asset to the host company.

We are also working to secure funding for stipends for our interns.


