President's Message

Recently, Los Angeles passed an ordinance raising the minimum wage there in annual increasses to \$15 an hour by 2020. Los Angeles County is considering a similar proposal. Mirroring the Los Angeles effort, activists in the Pasadena area are beginning to push to increase the minimum wage in our city.

The Pasadena Chamber Board of Directors has not taken a position yet, as there is not a proposal. (Though we anticipate an effort to mirror the Los Angeles ordinance.)

The Chamber does represent a significant number of businesses that would be affected by an increase to the minimum wage.

Restaurant members are very concerned about the impact and whether or not tipped employees would be exempted from any increases. Many local retailers who employ minimum wage, parttime and teenaged employees are worried about the impact, as are home health care providers, who rely on Medicaid and MediCal reimbursements which are not anticipated to increase.

Very concerning for the Chamber and many of our non-profit members, would be the impact on youth employment opportunities. If the minimum wage increases, without an exemption for training and/or young people in part-time employment, we are concerned that opportunities for young people in our community will be decreased significantly.

The Pasadena Chamber is very concerned about the impact a city minimum wage increase may have on our members, especially those locally owned, small businesses that drive much of our economic prosperity.

We are also aware that only about 25% of the people who work in Pasadena actually live here. Would a minimum wage increase in Pasadena actually benefit people living here? Also, absent similar increases in our neighboring cities (other than L.A.) would Pasadena acting alone incentivize businesses to leave for our less expensive neighbors?

Before any action is considered, the Pasadena Chamber will be requesting a full and independent analysis of the impact a local minimum wage increase could have on our businesses, our economy and our city.


