President's Message On March 9, 1888, a public meeting

On March 9, 1888, a public meeting was held at Williams Hall in Pasadena. At that meeting, it was decided that Pasadena would form a Board of Trade to act as an advocate for the growing local business community and to promote Pasadena to potential investors. Their names adorn the streets, alleys and neighborhoods of present-day Pasadena.

At a time when Pasadena's population hovered around 3000 persons, these men (yes, at that time they were all men) had a vision for a robust and thriving city based around agriculture and commerce.

After adopting by-laws and electing a Board of Directors, one of their first orders of business was to align themselves with the nascent national chamber of commerce movement. The Board of Trade was also one of the founding members of the Los Angeles Area Chamber of Commerce.

The Board of Trade, which officially became the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce in 1918, advocated for civic improvements within the City of Pasadena, including street beautification, road improvements and building schools. In the early days, the Board of Trade advocated for a dedicated public water company to serve Pasadena, and ensure a reliable supply of water for our orange groves. They also promoted the formation of Pasadena's first citizen advisory commission and raised money to build public schools.

Today, the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce carries on the legacy of the original founders of the Pasadena Board of Trade. We advocate for adequate and reliable public infrastructure, an excellent quality of life for all and a vibrant economy. We also provide effective service to our members.

On May 30th, we will celebrate our 125 years history with a cocktail reception and party. Look for an invitation with more details and plan to join us as we celebrate the 125th anniversary of the founding of the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce.
