President's Message

Yes, the holidays are fast approaching, but first we have to get through (survive?) the election season.

The Chamber does not endorse candidates, but does take positions on initiatives. Our Board makes decisions based on perceived benefits to members and our economy. They get input from our Legislative Committee and feedback from members.

Here are positions on issues before the voters on November 6th:

- Pasadena Measure I: OPPOSE the sales tax increase after a poll of members indicated 77% oppose it. NO POSITION on Measure J.
- LA County Measure W: OPPOSE the stormwater assessment because the cost is extremely onerous for all private real estate owners.
- Proposition 1: SUPPORT the measure funding veteran housing.
- Proposition 2: SUPPORT reprograming current funding to aid the homeless and mentally ill.
- Proposition 3: SUPPORT reliability and improve water quality, particularly needed in SoCal.
- Proposition 4: SUPPORT increasing capacity and improving services at children's hospitals in California.
- Proposition 5: SUPPORT facilitating the transfer of real estate protecting the financial health of those on fixed incomes.
- Proposition 6: OPPOSE because road and street repair and transit construction are necessary to the economic health of California.
- Proposition 7: SUPPORT allowing California to choose the best means to serve our citizens.
- Proposition 8: OPPOSE the measure as an unnecessary intrusion on the workplace with rules that will not improve patient service.
- Proposition 10: OPPOSE rent control restrictions and could exacerbate our massive housing shortage.
- Proposition 11: SUPPORT enhancing response time of emergency medical personnel.

Vote on November 6th. It matters!


