Originally incorporated as the Pasadena Board of Trade in 1888, the Chamber of Commerce played a pivotal role in the development and funding of Pasadena's schools, libraries, hospital, City Hall and the iconic Colorado Street Bridge.

In 1890, the Board of Trade proposed the Tournament of Roses Association, which is responsible for the Rose Parade and Rose Bowl game. The Board raised money for the Colorado Street Bridge and proposed creation of our municipal electric and water companies.

After 27 years of operation in New York, Honeybee Robotics opened its West Coast operations facility with the help of the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce.
