Originally incorporated as the Pasadena Board of Trade in 1888, the Chamber of Commerce played a pivotal role in the development and funding of Pasadena's schools, libraries, hospital, and city hall.

In 1890, the Board of Trade helped establish the Tournament of Roses Association, which assumed the responsibilities of the Valley Hunt Club for the annual Rose Parade, one of the key elements in the city's development.

After 27 years of operation in New York, Honeybee Robotics opened its West Coast operations facility with the help of the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce. We decided to open a facility in Pasadena and began talking to the Chamber staff about the best site to locate our company. In 1918, The Board of Trade became the Pasadena Chamber of Commerce. In the 1920s, the Chamber passed the bond measure that paid to construct the Colorado Street Bridge linking Pasadena to our neighboring communities to the west. It continued to play an important role in the city's growth and development throughout the 20th century. The Chamber was instrumental in establishing Pasadena as a headquarters city for companies such as Parsons, Avery Dennison and Western Asset Management and AT&T. Chamber advocacy was also crucial to bringing the Gold Line light rail system to Pasadena.

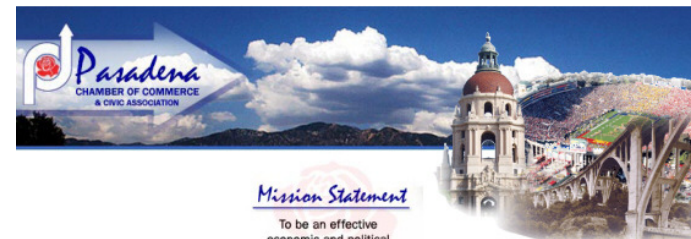

Base of \$1650, plus \$2 per room.

Base of \$230 per office for the broker and up to two employees. Independent contractors (Realtors) can be added as individual members for \$110 each with full member privileges as long as they remain associated with the base member.

Professional Services *(Doctors, Lawyers, CPAs)*

Base of \$230 per office plus \$110 for each additional partner in the member office.

Churches

\$330 annually, with no processing fee.

Community Based Non-Profit Service Providers (ten employees or fewer)

\$165 annually, with no processing fee.

Individuals

\$110 annual investment.

Available only to persons not engaged in active commerce.
