As we ease into the summer months, it is a good time to use these slower months to evaluate the first half of the year and plan for the remainder of 2018.

At the Chamber, we look at our outreach, events and activities regularly, assessing the effectiveness of our communications tools and initiatives to support our members and the greater Pasadena economy.

Often, we retool an existing event to better serve our members, as we did in turning our annual business showcase in the Taste of Pasadena at the Rose Bowl. That event generates revenue for the Chamber, showcases our restaurant members and provides exhibition space for some of our business members. At the same time, the event draws a somewhat different audience than many of our other activities.

We retooled the Tri-City Mixer with Burbank and Glendale to focus on our neighbor chambers. The SGV Chambers After Dark event at Noor in May was tremendously successful, with attendees from Altadena, El Monte/ South El Monte, La Canada Flintridge, San Gabriel, The San Gabriel Valley Black Chamber of Commerce, South Pasadena and Temple City joining Pasadena Chamber members for an evening of fun and networking. Look for that to return again next spring.

We sometimes choose to change how we communicate. We have aggressively pursued social media and used our blog to communicate with members and the community. We have found, at the same time, that our printed newsletter has had declining readership. So few members want to receive the hard copy version that we are ceasing printing it altogether.



SIP-tember competitors serve drinks that are paired against each other in a competition. Drinks being offered for the challenge include special margaritas, new interpretations of traditional cocktails and some specially created drinks from some of Pasadena's premiere mixologists. 
