President's Message

The Chamber's Pasadena Business and Economic Summit is a great partnership between the City of Pasadena and the Chamber. Each year, now in our fifth, we bring business leaders and community members together to hear about the state of our economy, economic activity in Pasadena and a discussion of issues pertaining to one or more of our leading industries.

Each year, the Pasadena Business and Economic Summit has evolved with input and guidance from our Economic and Business Development Committee and City Economic Development Department staff. The first couple of years focused on presentations by economists and industry experts. We heard from leaders of local business and economic development organizations, local business leaders and industry experts. Panel topics ranged from overseas investment in Pasadena and commercial real estate trends to expectations of millennials in the workplace and the health of our hospitality industry.

This year, we will begin with an economic overview, presented by Bill Allen, CEO of the LAEDC, and a presentation on local initiatives by City Economic Development Manager Eric Duyshart. That will be followed by a panel discussion moderated by Karl Bird, Acquisitions Manager at JPL and chair-elect of the Chamber.

This year's panel will focus on the evolving experience for consumers at cultural institutions, entertainment and much more. Panelists will include Phil Hettema of The Hettema Group and Michael Shanklin Chief Executive Officer of Kidspace Children's Museum. We have also invited a mobile app and entertainment content development company CEO. We anticipate a lively and informative discussion about Evolving Expectations and the Consumer Experience.

The Economic Summit is a great opportunity to hear about the local economy. It is also a chance to meet and hear from some of the innovators and business leaders in Pasadena.


Lunch and breakfast are \$25 for members/\$30 for nonmembers. Those reserving after the deadline pay \$5 more.
