Ensure Compliance with State and Local Regulations

Businesses in California are required by law to arrange for recycling and organics recycling services.

Becoming a Pasadena Zero Waste Partner ensures you are compliant with the following regulations and any future waste reduction requirements.



Assembly Bill 341

Requires all businesses that generate (4) cubic yards or more of waste per week to arrange for recycling services.



Assembly Bill 1826

Requires all businesses that generate four (4) cubic yards or more of organic waste per week to arrange for organics recycling services.



Polystyrene Ban Ordinance

(PMC 8.67, Ordinance No. 7284) The use or sale of polystyrene food packaging is banned in the City of Pasadena effective August 22, 2017.

All Program applicants and participants must be in compliance with all local, state and federal regulations.

The final decision of partnership approval rests with the City of Pasadena.
